Re: Nationwide Survey of Workplace Wellbeing in New Zealand Emergency Departments (EDs) 2020

The study is a nationwide survey of emergency department staff feelings of wellbeing including self-care strategies. It is part of the applicant's completion of a Master's Degree. About 1000 staff members are expected to participate nationwide, 60 to 150 of these are likely to be Māori. At Auckland DHB there will be about 250 participants, 14 of whom might be Māori. Ethnicity data will be gathered and an analysis done by ethnicity.

While the questionnaires are generic they are broad enough to capture Māori realities in the work place and responses will be confidential.

On behalf of the Waitematā and Auckland District Health Boards Māori Research Committee the study has been approved.
